



## DIRECTIONS TO CREATE PLANT GEL IN DIFFERENT COLORS:

- 1. Pour 1 gallon of *Distilled* water into a large bowl or container (Use Distilled water only).
- 2. Add 2 tablespoons of PLANT GEL crystals to the water and let it sit for at least 4 to 5 hours. The crystals will slowly absorb the water. 2 Tablespoons make 1 gallon of gel.
- 3. Pour the wet PLANT GEL into a strainer to remove excess water and let stand for at least 2 hours.
- 4. Pour the PLANT GEL from the strainer into a bowl for mixing.
- 5. Add PLANT COLORING (Food Coloring or Icing Gels) one drop at a time and stir with a spoon to mix it in, until you get the color you want. \*\*Do not add too much color, or the gel will start to smell after a while.\*\* Make light colors, not dark colors.

You can use any food coloring or icing gels used to make cakes. All supermarkets carry them. Icing gels come in small round jars for about 1 dollar each. They are in the baking section of the supermarket.

## If you want to dehydrate the gel into colored crystals:

Once you color the gel, pour it onto something like a cookie sheet and let the water dry out. Leave it sitting out until completely dry. This will take a few weeks. Once it dries into a crystal. You can package and sell it.
